UPCité - Medical School

1

Université Paris Cité (UPCité) is the result of the merger of Paris Descartes and Paris Diderot universities in 2020, including the Institut de Physique du Globe de Paris. UPCité offers one of the most complete and ambitious multidisciplinary education and research in Paris, with a strong international reputation. It is a research-intensive university affiliated with international level research institutions, such as the Imagine Institute www.institutimagine.org/en/ and the Pasteur Institute www.pasteur.fr/en/.

The Medical School, which is part of the Faculty of Health, is the largest medical school in France with approximately 800 students enrolled each year for a six-year undergraduate curriculum, several thousands of residents, interns and fellows; the total researchers and teaching faculty reaches 1,400, and 500 administrative staff. Altogether, around **25,000 students** are enrolled at the school, and the research carried out in the 34 research units represents almosts 25% of INSERM's (French National Institute of Health and Medical Research) research potential. Medical students complete their clinical rotations in the 19 affiliated teaching hospitals, where all medical and surgical specialities are represented, including two major children's hospitals. The hospitals are all part of the Assistance-Publique Hôpitaux de Paris (AP-HP) healthcare network in and around Paris.

The International Relations Office

Our overall aim is to allow our students and our partners' students to discover different medical systems and cultures during their studies, in order to enhance their experiences and broaden their perspectives. This is achieved through academic exchanges, clinical electives abroad, research opportunities and summer schools, as well as internationalization from home programs. We believe that international exposure for medical students is crucial to prepare globally conscious, culturally competent medical doctors, who will be skilled to address international health challenges. The team includes five full-time administrative staff, including the Director, and an Academic Head, with a team of 10 faculty, in charge of the academic supervision.

Student mobility is at the heart of the team's action. In this regard, the team is responsible for implementing international mobility programs (Erasmus+, clinical electives abroad, summer schools, etc.). Each year, the School sends and welcomes between 40 and 60 students on Erasmus academic exchanges and approximately 250 students for clinical placements across all continents. On top of the Erasmus+ mobility program, we have 50+ partners around the world, and are a founding partner of Circle U, an alliance of nine research-intensive universities from across Europe.

We also develop a strong European collaboration through European Union funded innovative teaching programs, such as the IDEALiTER program (<u>ideal.u-paris.fr</u>), which enhances international teaching collaboration across 12 partner universities (see section 7). Finally, the international office builds strong partnerships with highly ranked universities across the world to encourage research collaborations, as well as through its global health initiatives.



► HOW TO APPLY?

Application submission at your home university

- Duration : 1 to 3 months
- Level of study required during the mobility : between Year 4 and Year 6 of Medical School
- · French and English tracks available

The Summer Schools offered by the Medical School are two-week programs, conducted entirely in English, combining academic excellence, practical learning, and French medical expertise.

Designed and supervised by an internationally renowned teaching team in the field of medicine, these programs offer a unique opportunity to interact with experts who are redefining the future of medical practice.

Two themes are offered to an audience of international students ranging from those studying medicine and health sciences to engineers and data scientists seeking an interdisciplinary approach.

Infectious Diseases Education Advanced Level for better Preparedness

PROJECT

IDEAL4PREPAREDNESS is the prolongation of the European projects IDEAL (2016-2019), IDEAL+ (2019-2022) and IDEALiTER (2022-2025). It establishes a common curriculum in infectious diseases and promotes innovative and interactive teaching methods (https://ideal.u-paris.fr/).

Focusing on theinterprofessional communication through the spectrum of infectious diseases, IDEAL4PREPAREDNESS (Infectious **D**iseases **E**ducation **A**dvanced **L**evel for better Preparedness) is a program that builds a solid shared expertise across a wide network of European institutions. It develops innovative teaching practices through case-based learning and real-life simulations, offering an immersive learning experience. The program is designed to include both undergraduate and postgraduate students, with all courses delivered in English.

The program offers advanced training sessions for students, an annual « TrainThe Trainers » seminar for young healthcare professionals and an annual summer school.

Planetary Health in European Medical Education

■ PROJECT

PHEMED aims to integrate the ecological crisis into medical education. In collaboration with European partners (Berlin, Aarhus, Nicosia, Planetary Health Alliance), it is developing a course on planetary health to help students and teachers understand the link between human health and ecosystems. The goal: to train ambassadors of change towards a sustainable healthcare system, through a student-centered, collaborative, and innovative approach.

TRAINING SESSIONS AND ACTIVITIES

The project provides interdisciplinary resources and a comprehensive program for medical students and teachers. Activities include professional training, online learning with European partners, and summer schools. A digital platform will extend these initiatives and foster a community of future leaders in planetary health.
