

LABEX WHO AM I? 2020 THEMATIC PROJECT CALL

The Who Am I? Thematic Program is designed to support the Labex teams in the development of their core research projects. As part of this program, there will be **only one thematic project call** that will fund individual research projects submitted by Who Am I? partners' teams and focusing on the Labex scientific themes: (i) *Transmission of identity across generations*, (ii) *Integrity in response to stress and challenge* and (iii) *Plasticity and changes in identity*. The relevance to Identity and more precisely to the Labex themes constitutes a major eligibility criteria and should be clearly explained in the proposal. Collaboration between teams and interdisciplinarity are encouraged but not mandatory.

Reviewers from various disciplines will evaluate the submitted proposals. Therefore, a specific attention should be given to wording to ensure that proposals can be understood by non-expert.

Each project will be granted with 120 kEuros, for personnel cost only. The category of the recruited personnel (PhD, post-doc, technical assistant or engineer) is not pre-determined but chosen by the teams, as the more appropriate to implement their project. All funded projects and associated work contracts should be finished by the end of December 2024.

Please note that no other call of this type will be launched for the whole Labex renewal period (2020-2024).

Evaluation procedure:

The proposals will be evaluated in two steps: first, the Labex Executive Committee will pre-select scientific proposals, and then the short-listed proposals will be evaluated by the Who Am I? Scientific Advisory Board. Evaluation criteria are the following:

- The scientific quality of the project
- The relevance to identity and to strengthening the Who Am I? scientific themes
- The feasibility of the proposal given the allocated budget and time

Eligibility criteria:

- The host laboratory should be part of the Who Am I? consortium.
- The submitted proposals should aim at strengthening the labex scientific themes

Funding: 120 kEuros, for personnel cost only.

Application: The Research Proposal should be submitted on the dedicated platform (the link will be communicated shortly).

Deadline: January 22th, 2021

Research Proposal: The Research proposal (4 pages maximum) should include the following information and sections. Please do not add annexes, longer proposals will not be considered.
